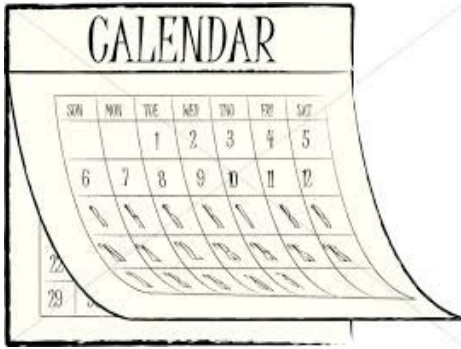
Chad Jacobs(President) reported on show buttons and it was decided that the buttons from last years postponed show would be used.

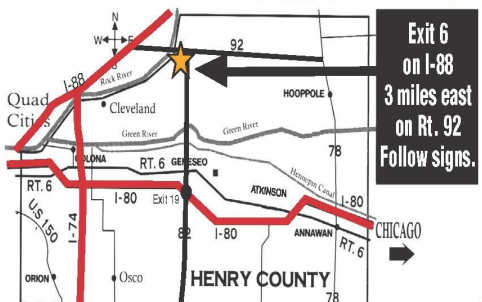
