



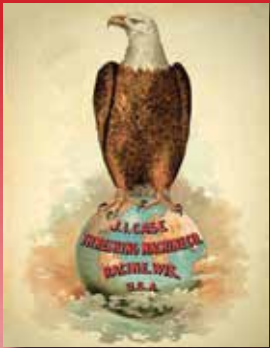

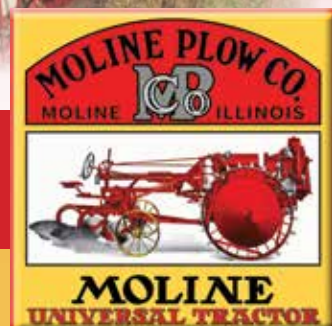

# Honoring Larry Gay

A very special thanks to AETA member Larry Gay. Over the years Larry has provided many great articles for the AETA newsletter, the annual show booklet and upcoming featured tractors.

Loren Book shows the technique for detaching the rear carriage from his Model D Orchard tractor and connecting to a separate implement.

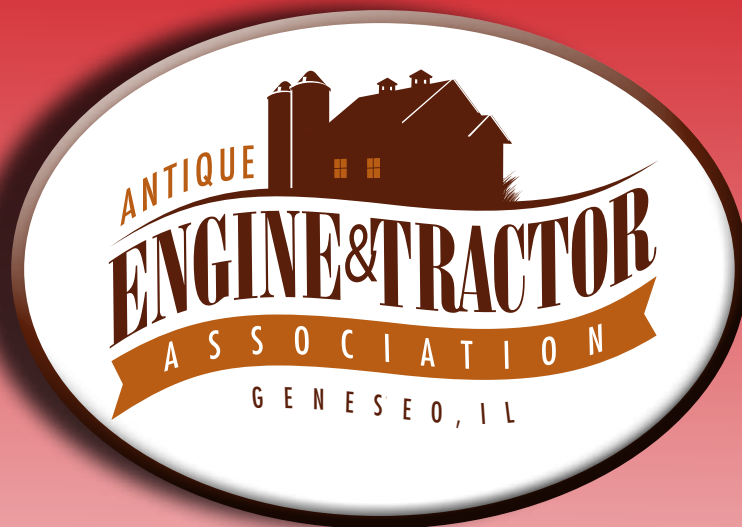

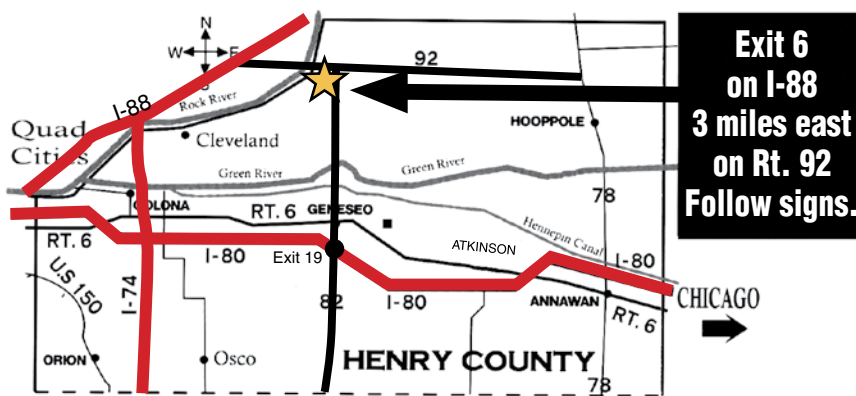
